Introduction

As a customer, you have free access to both a Taxpayer mobile app (TaxPass) for your clients as well as an ERO app (ERO Go) for managing your tax offices. These apps work directly with one another to provide you and your taxpayers an unparalleled customer experience.

TaxPass - Taxpayer Mobile App

Your tax business now has its own mobile app for your taxpayers – all with your own name and logo. And you didn't have to spend time or money developing it!

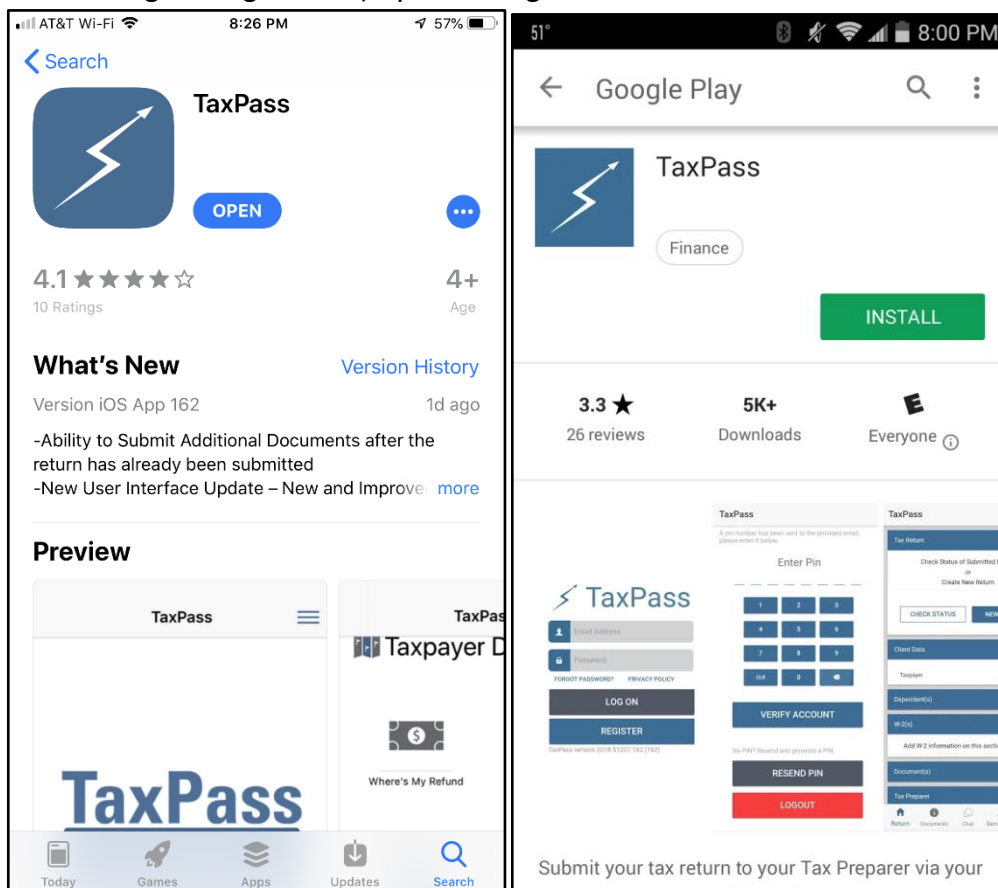
TaxPass Features:

- A user-friendly interface allowing the taxpayer to input their information to facilitate to the tax preparer.
- Ability to scan the taxpayer's driver license or state ID to import information into the client data screen(s).
- Ability to upload tax documents to send to the tax preparer.
- Ability to check the remote signature status of their return.
- Ability to chat by sending and receiving messages between the taxpayer and the tax preparer.
- Ability to check the status of their return
- Ability to view the location of their tax preparers' office.

TaxPass

Downloading and Installing the TaxPass Mobile App

- In order to use the TaxPass mobile app, the taxpayer will need to first download the app from the App Store (for iOS devices – left image below) or the Play Store (for Android devices – right image below) by searching for “TaxPass.”



- TaxPass will only work on iOS devices running iOS 9.0 or higher and on Android devices running Android 4.1 (Jelly Bean) or higher.
Note: TaxPass will run slower on older devices compared to newer devices (for example, TaxPass will run slower on a device running Android 4.4.4 as opposed to a device on the latest version of Android)
- Once the taxpayer has downloaded and installed TaxPass to their device, the next step is to create a TaxPass account.

Registering for a TaxPass Account

- When the taxpayer launches the TaxPass app for the first time, a login screen will appear.

TaxPass

- Here the taxpayer has two buttons to click on:
 1. **Log On:** Allows the taxpayer log in to their existing account after inputting their email and password above.
 2. **Register:** Allows the taxpayer to register for a new account.

- If this is the taxpayer first time using TaxPass, they will click on the Register button at the login screen to create a new account.
- At the Register Account screen, the taxpayer will enter a valid email address and verify it below.
- Beneath the email fields, the taxpayer will enter in a password and verify it below.

Note: The created password will need to conform to NIST requirements, which includes:

 1. A minimum of 8 characters
 2. 1 uppercase letter
 3. 1 lowercase letter
 4. 1 number
 5. 1 special character
- Below the password field is the Mobile App ID field. The Mobile App ID is a unique ID consisting of a QR barcode and eight unique characters, generated by the ERO from the ERO Go mobile app or via the web portal. This ID determines where the return will be sent.

TaxPass

Note: The Mobile App ID is not required when the taxpayer registers for a new account. However, it will be required in order to submit the return to their tax preparer. If it is not entered at the Register Account screen, the taxpayer will be able to enter it at a later date within the app (more on that later.)

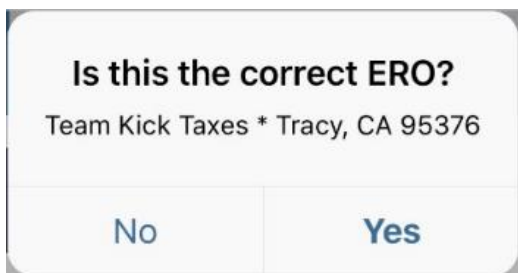
- If the ERO has provided the taxpayer with the Mobile App ID, the taxpayer can enter the code manually in this field or scan the QR code by clicking on the Scan button next to this field. Scanning the QR barcode will automatically populate this field with the eight-character code. Otherwise, they may leave this field blank.
- The taxpayer will need to accept the privacy policy by placing a check mark in the proper field and then click on Register to create the account.

Note: If there is an existing account with that email, the taxpayer will receive an error indicating that the username already exists.

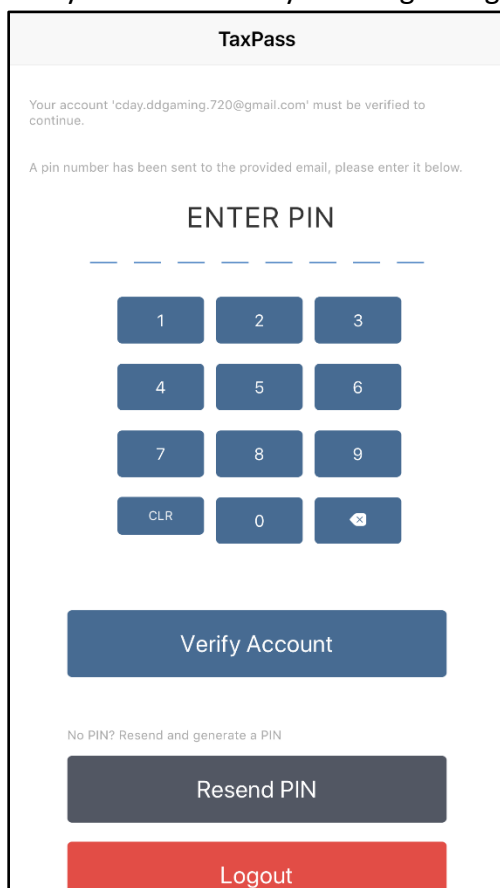

- The taxpayer will click on Yes to verify that that the scanned code belongs to their tax preparer.
- Once the taxpayer clicks on Yes on this pop-up OR if they clicked on Register without entering a Mobile App ID, they will then need to verify their email address.

Verifying the New TaxPass Account

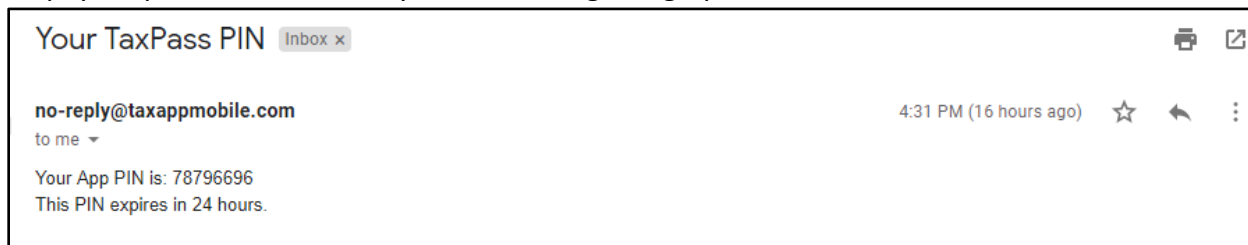
- After the taxpayer has clicked on Register, they will receive a screen where they will need to verify their account by entering an eight-digit pin number.



- This eight-digit pin will be sent to the email address used to create the account. The taxpayer will need to login to their email to retrieve this unique pin.

TaxPass

- The email containing the Pin will have a subject header “Your TaxPass PIN”. Once the taxpayer opens this email, they will see an eight-digit pin number.



Note: If the taxpayer does enter this pin within 24 hours, as indicated in the email, they will need to click on Resend Pin on their next login to receive a new pin number.

- The taxpayer will enter this pin in TaxPass and then click on the Verify Account button (left image below.) Once they verify their account, the taxpayer will see the Tax Return menu to start a new return.

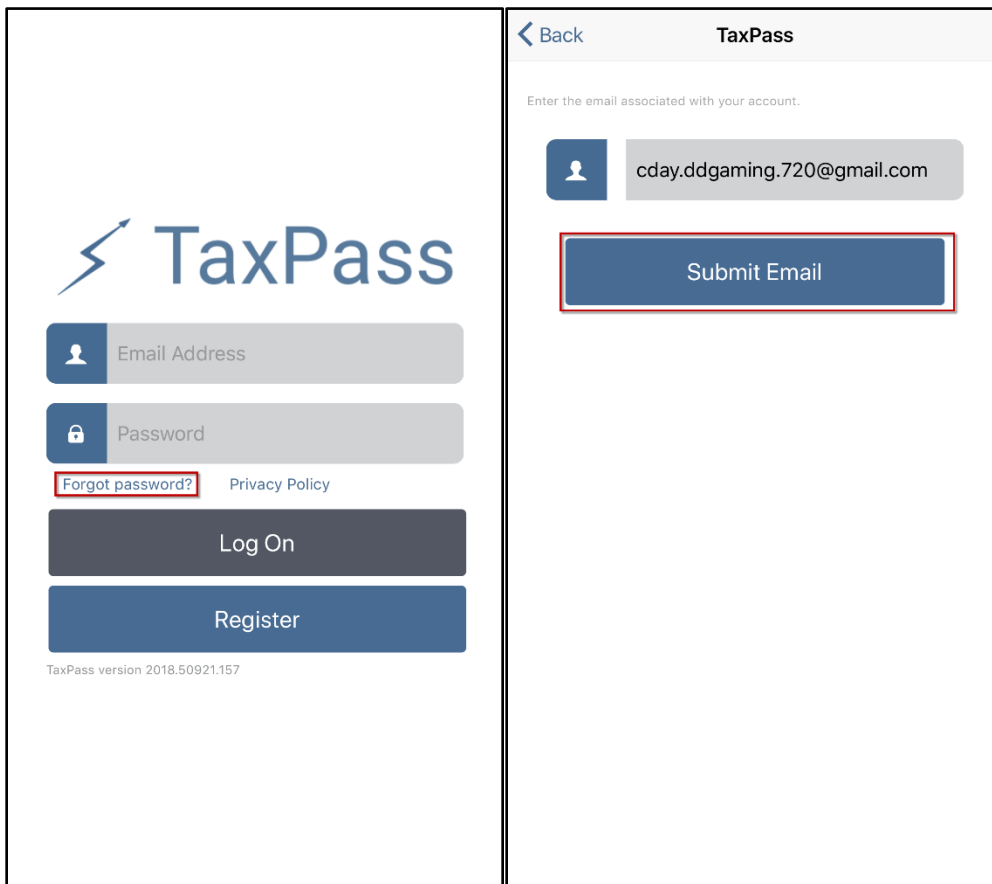
Logging In/Resetting the TaxPass Account

- If the taxpayer has already created a Taxpass account, then they will enter the email address for their account in the Username field and their password in the Password field.
- Once the taxpayer has entered their login credentials, they will click on the Log On button, to login to their account.

- If the taxpayer does not remember their password for their TaxPass account, they will need to click on the “*Forgot password?*” link underneath the Password field (left image below.)
- Once taxpayer clicks on this link, a new screen will appear prompting the taxpayer to enter in their TaxPass account email address. After they enter in their email, they will click on the Submit Email button (right image below.)

- Once the taxpayer clicks on the Submit Email button, an email containing an eight-digit pin will be sent to the email entered here and a new screen will appear in the app, prompting the taxpayer to enter this same pin.
Note: This step is like the account verification process when the taxpayer registers for a new account.
- After entering this pin, a new password will need to be entered and confirmed. Afterwards the taxpayer will click on the Submit Password button (left image below.)
Note: This new password must meet the NIST compliance standards as described in the “Registering for a TaxPass Account” section and cannot be a previously used password.
- After clicking on the Submit Password button, the taxpayer will be taken back to the login screen and a message will appear at the bottom of the screen indicating that the password was successfully reset. They can now login with the new password (right image below.)

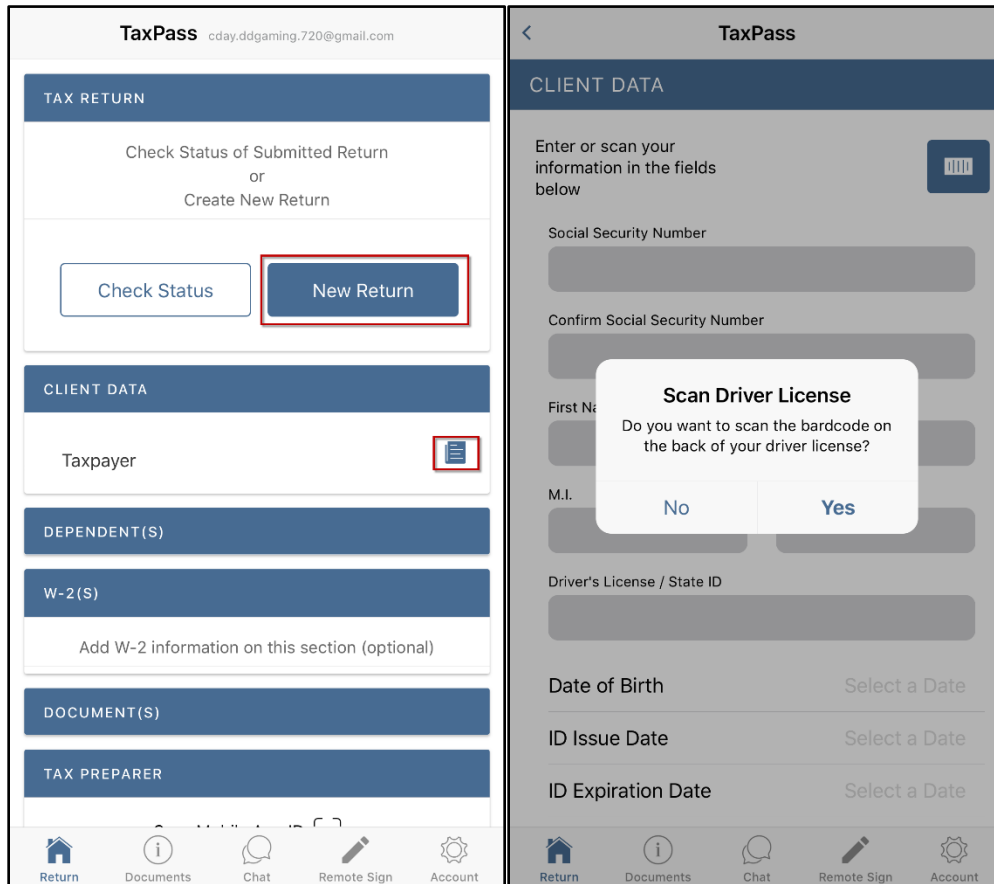
Return Menu

Starting a New Tax Return and Scanning the Driver License/State Issued ID (Optional)

- Once the taxpayer successfully creates a TaxPass account, they will click on the "New Return" button or the edit icon next to the Taxpayer field on the Client Data section to start a new return (left image below.)
- After clicking on Yes, a pop-up will appear asking the taxpayer if they would like to scan their driver's license or state issued ID barcode (right image below - a device with a camera is required for this step.)

Note: This pop-up is optional. The taxpayer is not required to scan their driver's license or state issued ID and may enter in this information manually on the client data screen.

- If the taxpayer clicks on Yes, the device's camera will launch so that the taxpayer can scan the ID's barcode. Once scanned, the Client Data screen will auto-populate with the information from the scanned ID.
- If they click on No, then the pop-up will close, and the taxpayer will need to enter in this information manually.
- The taxpayer can also launch the scan option by clicking on the blue button above the social security number field, if the taxpayer clicked on No during the initial pop-up.

TaxPass

Completing the Client Data screen(s)

- After the taxpayer has clicked Yes or No on the Scan Driver's License pop-up, they will need to complete the rest of the Client Data screens.

Note: Only the fields with an * are required.

- Social Security Number***: Input the taxpayer's social security number.
- Confirm Social Security Number***: Confirm the taxpayer's social security number above.
- First Name***: Input the taxpayer first name.
- M.I.**: Input the taxpayer's middle initial or leave blank.
- Last Name***: Input the taxpayer's last name.
- Driver's License / State ID**: Input the taxpayer's driver's license or state issued ID.
- Date of Birth***: Input the taxpayer's date of birth.
- ID Issue Date**: Input the issue date for the ID in step f.
- ID Expiration Date**: Input the expiration date for the ID in step f.
- License Type**: Select the type of ID in step f.
- License/ID State**: Select the ID state in step f.
- US Address***: Input the taxpayer's main address.
- City***: Input the city name for the address in step l.

- n. **Address State***: Select the taxpayer's residency state.
- o. **Zip***: Input the taxpayer's zip code for the address in step I.
- p. Click on **Continue**.

- q. **Filing Status**: Select the taxpayers' filing status.
- r. **Occupation**: Input the title of the taxpayer's occupation. (Example: Manager, Worker, Retired, Homemaker, Sales, etc.)

Note: This box is checked automatically if the selected filing status is MFJ.
 - hh. Click on **Save** (left image below.)
- After the taxpayer clicks on Save, the app will return to the Tax Return menu screen (right image below.)

Note: If the SSN entered on the Client Data screen has already been used in TaxPass, the taxpayer will receive a Service Error indicating so. TaxPass allows only one submission per SSN. Once an SSN has been submitted to a preparer from the app, that SSN is “locked” and cannot be submitted again (“First come, first served.”)

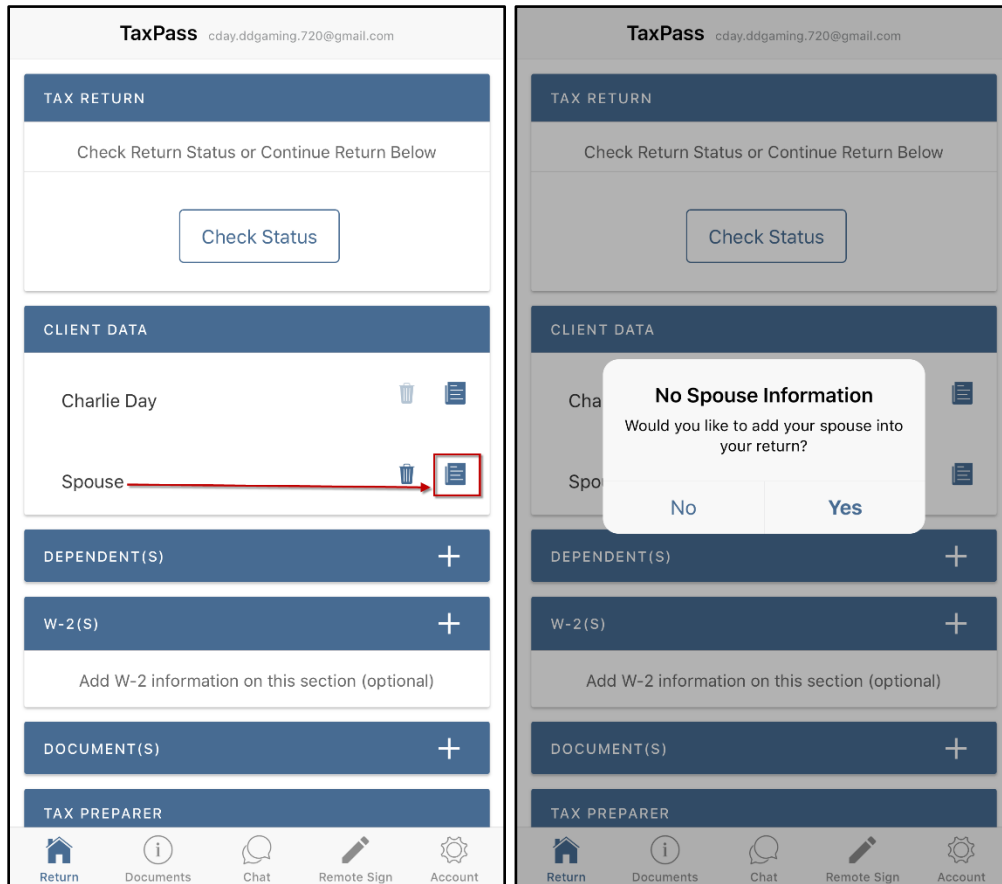

Completing the Spouse Data screen(s) (if required)

- After completing the Client Data screens, if the taxpayer check-marked the “Do you Have a Spouse?” option, the taxpayer will see a Spouse option below the taxpayer’s name. They will click on the edit icon (left image below.)
- Once the taxpayer clicks on edit, a pop-up will appear asking the taxpayer to enter in the Spouse information. Click on Yes to continue.

- The taxpayer will now need to complete the Spouse Data screens. These screens are similar to the Client Data screens for the taxpayer.

Note: It is possible to scan the spouse's driver license or state issue ID, like that of the primary taxpayer. Otherwise, only the fields with an * are required.

- Confirm Social Security Number*:** Confirm the spouse social security number above.
- First Name*:** Input spouse first name.
- M.I.:** Input spouse middle initial or leave blank.
- Last Name*:** Input spouse last name.
- Driver's License / State ID:** Input the spouse's driver's license or state issued ID.
- License/ID state:** Select the ID's state in step **f**.
- Date of Birth:** Input spouse date of birth.
- ID Issue Date:** Input the issue date for the ID in step **f**.
- ID Expiration Date:** Input the expiration date for the ID in step **f**.
- License Type:** Select the type of the ID in step **f**.

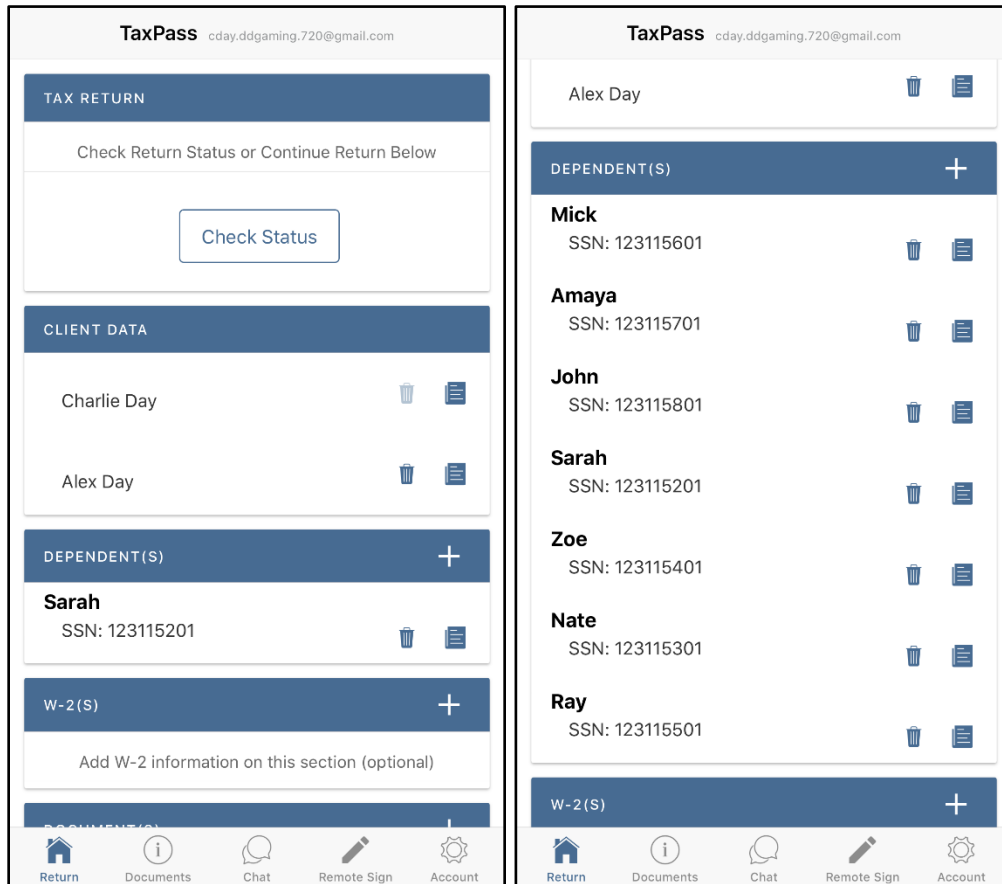

- If the taxpayer needs to edit a dependent's information, they may click on the edit icon to the right of the dependent's name and SSN (left image below.)
- The taxpayer can edit the dependent's information and click on Update (right image below.)

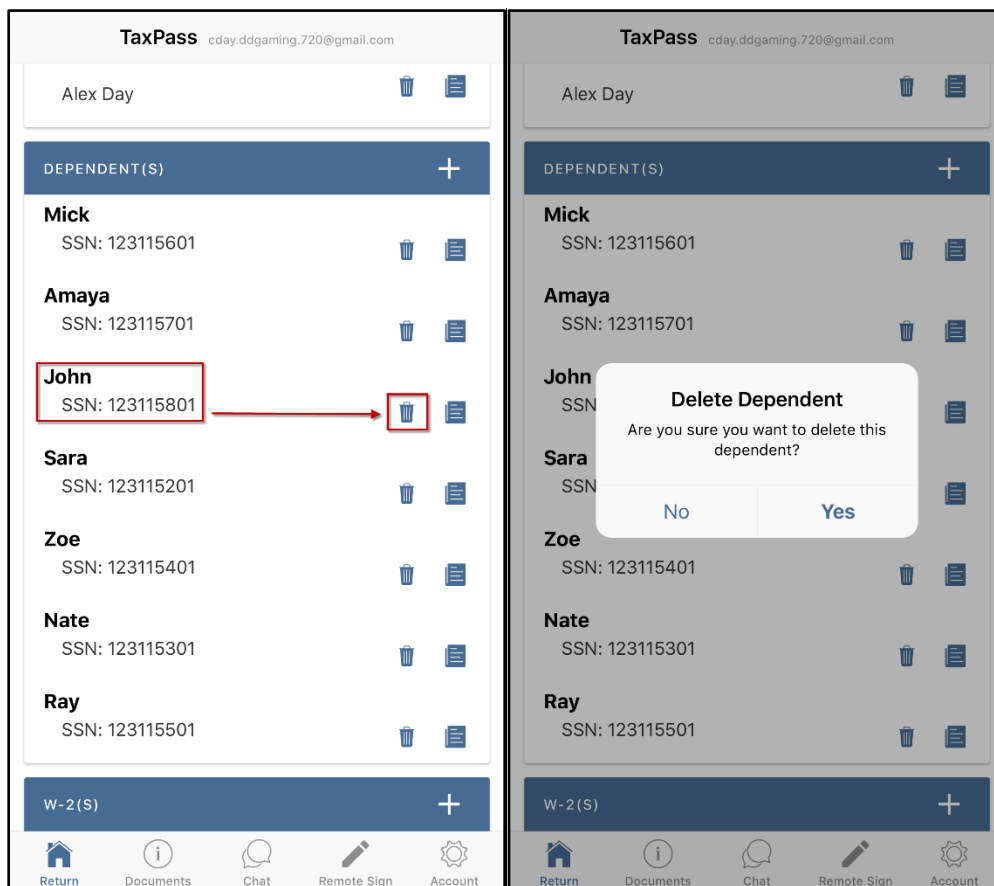

 - **W2:** upload W2 forms.
 - **1098:** upload 1098 forms

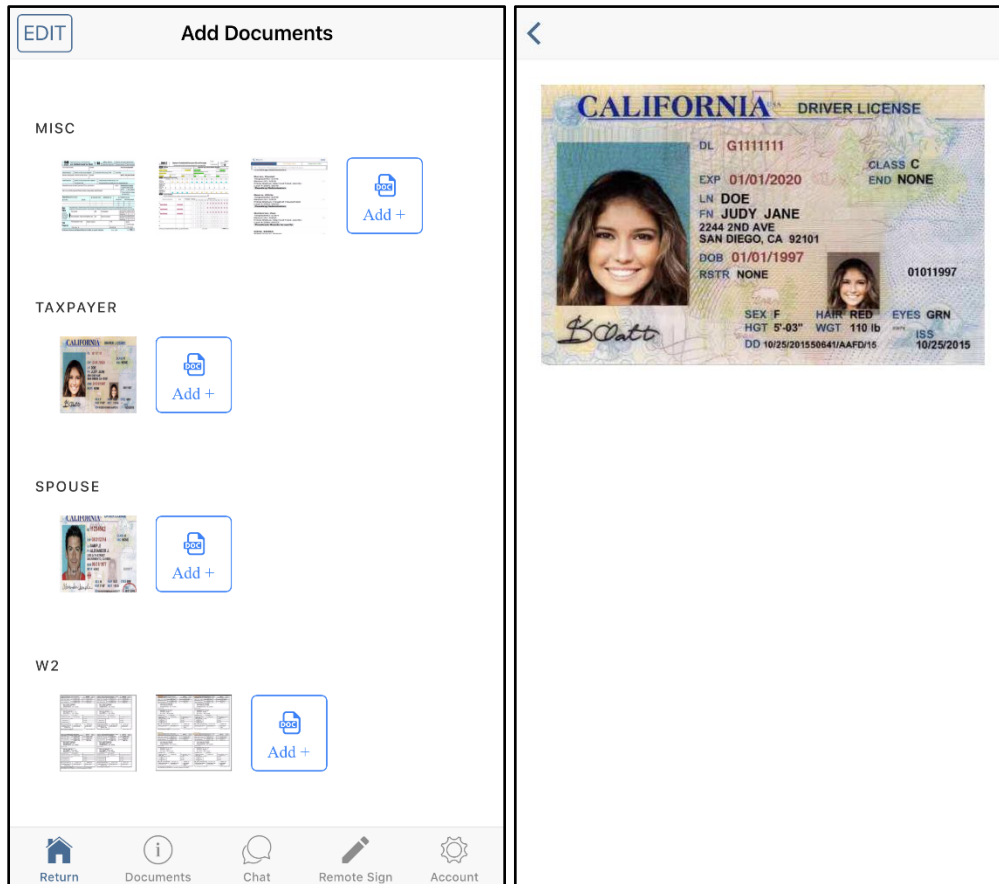
- To add a document to the return, the taxpayer will click on the Add button on one of the Document sections. Once they do, a pop-up will appear to add a document to the return one of two way (left image below):
 - **Capture Documents:** this will launch the devices camera to take a picture of the document to upload.
 - **Add from Gallery:** this will allow the taxpayer to select a saved picture from their device's picture gallery to upload into the app.
Note: Only one image may be uploaded at a time when adding a document from the gallery (cannot select multiple images at once.)
- Once a document has been uploaded, the image will be shown in the uploaded section (right image below.)

Entering the Mobile App ID and Submitting the Return to the Tax Preparer

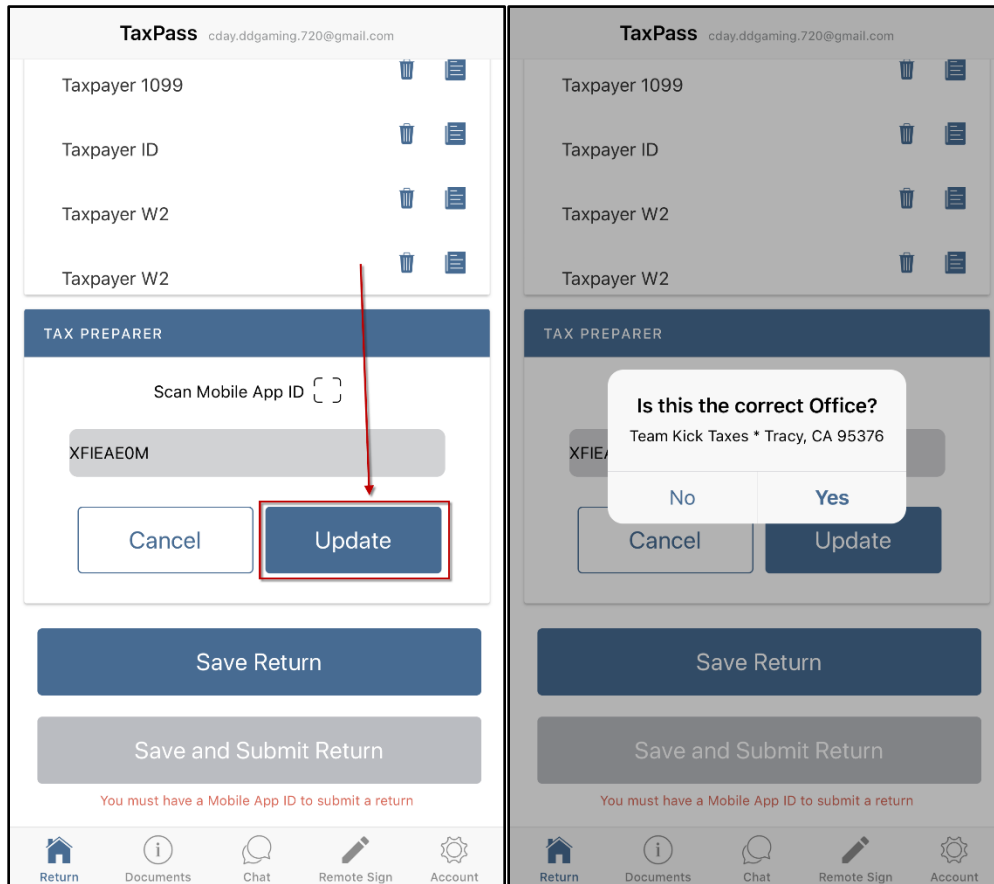
- If the taxpayer did not enter the Mobile App ID during the account registration, the taxpayer will need to enter it in the Tax Preparer section. The taxpayer can enter in this code manually in the Mobile App ID field or they can scan the Mobile App ID barcode by clicking on the scan button (left image below.)
- If they click on the scan button, a pop-up asking the taxpayer if they would like to scan their tax preparer's Mobile App ID barcode (right image below.)

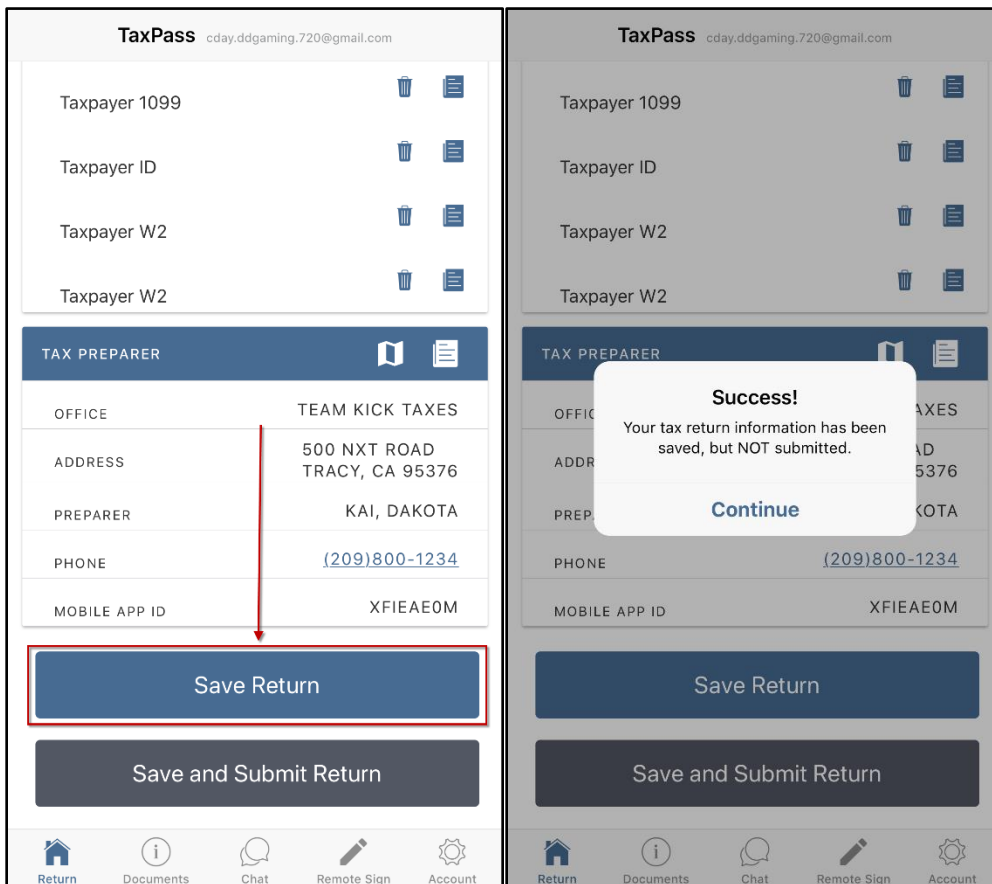

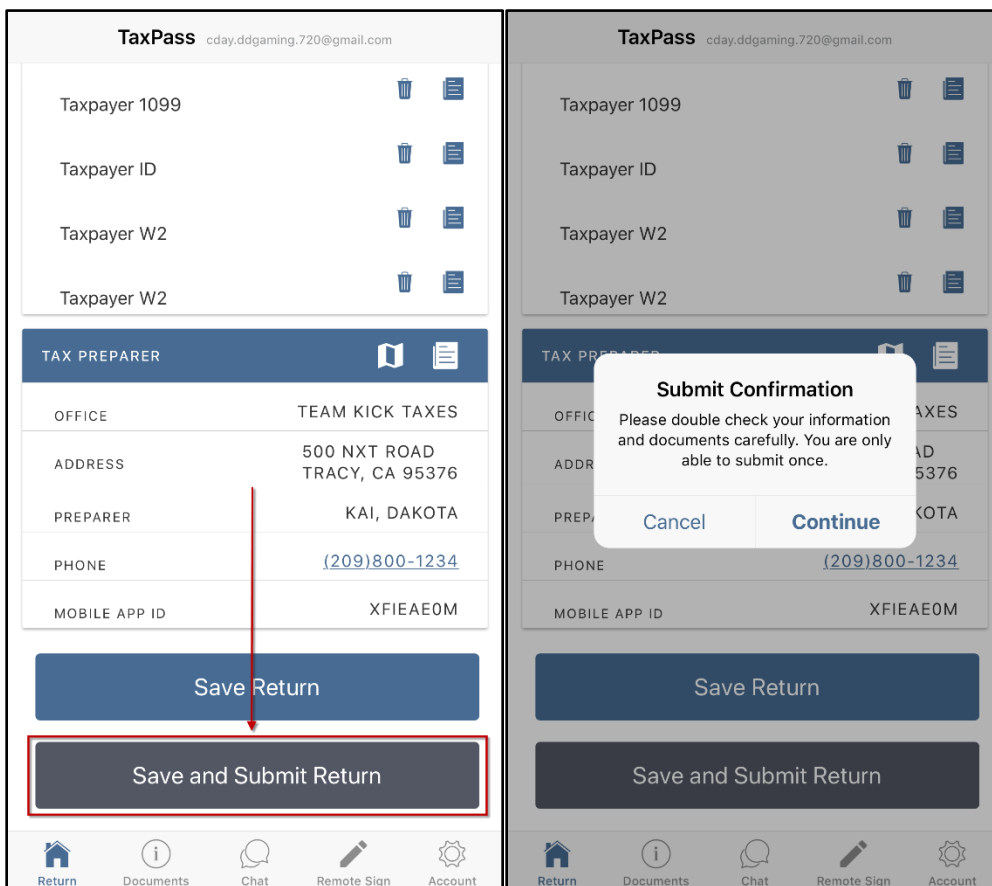

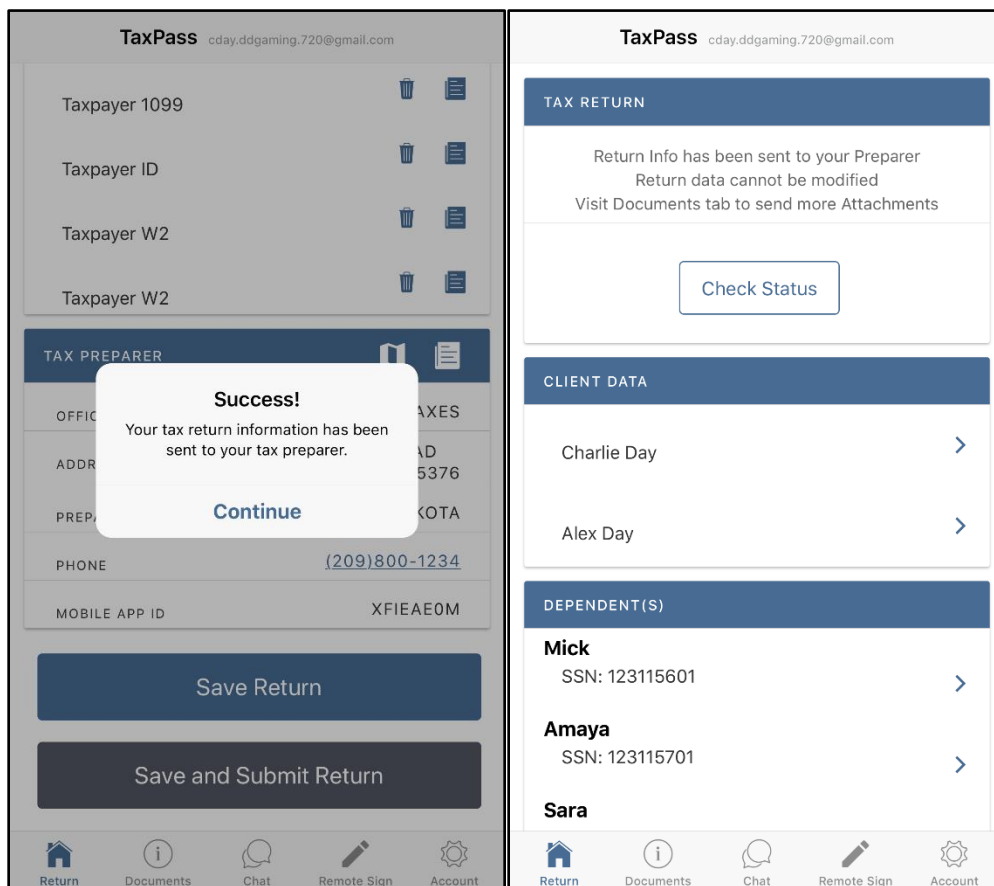
- Once the taxpayer enters clicks Save and Submit button, a pop-up will appear asking the taxpayer if they are certain that they would like to submit the return to the tax preparer (right image below.)
- **IMPORTANT:** Once a return has been submitted to the tax preparer the return is locked, and the taxpayer cannot add or edit any of the information on the data entry screens. However, they may still upload and submit documents after the return submission from the Documents menu.

- Once the taxpayer clicks on Continue on the Submit Confirmation pop-up above, the return will then be submitted to the tax preparer (left image below.)
- Once submitted, all of the sections in the Return menu become read-only/view-only fields (right image below.)

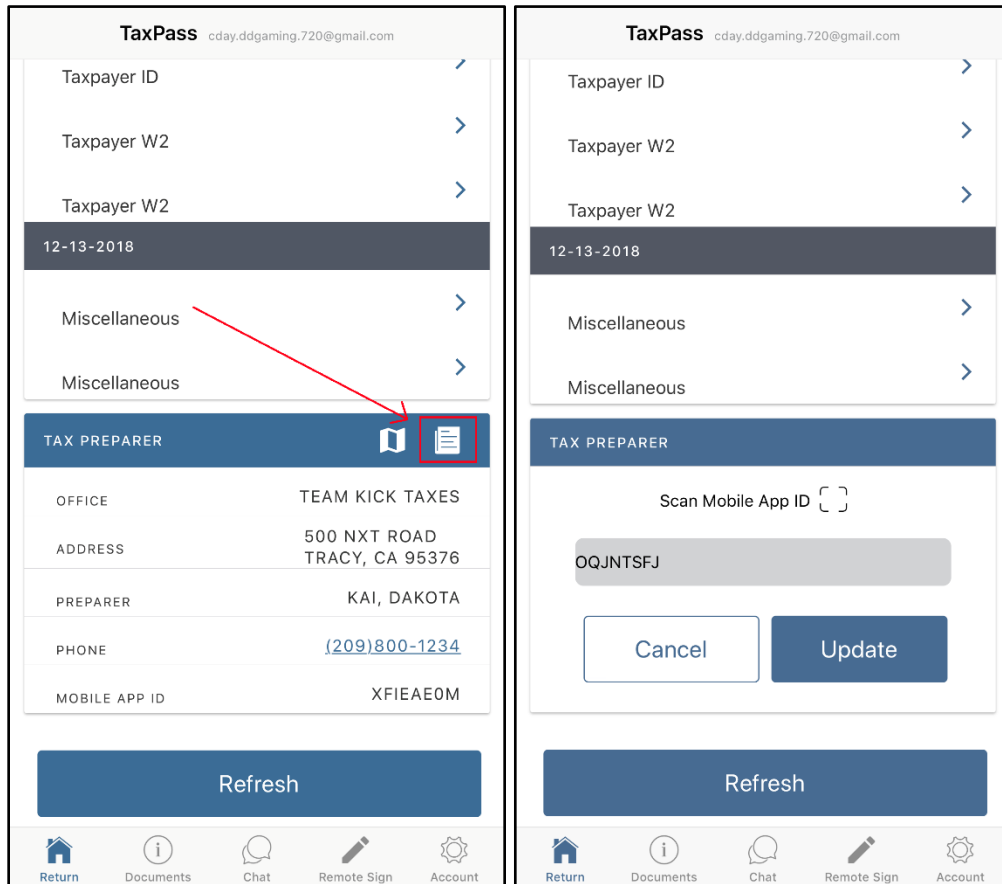
- If the taxpayer clicks on the arrow button next to the Taxpayer's name (as an example), they will be able to view the information entered and submitted to the tax preparer.
Note: Notice that all these fields are greyed out, if they click on any one of these sections. Remember, once the taxpayer submits their return information to the tax preparer, they cannot change any of this information and will be view-only.

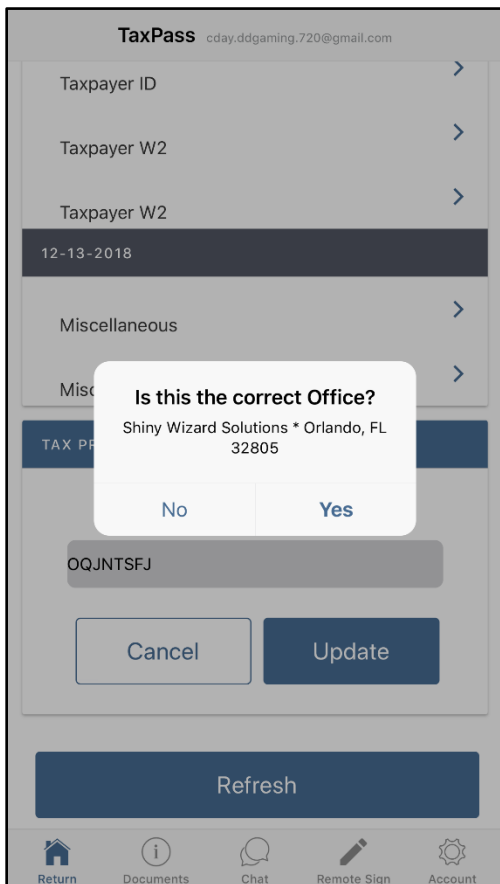
- Additionally, the tax payer may also resubmit their tax return to a different office by changing the Mobile App ID. To do this, they will click on the Edit button in the Tax Preparer section (left image below.)
- After clicking on the Edit button, the taxpayer will enter or scan the Mobile App ID for the new office/tax preparer (right image below.)

- Like before when entering the Mobile App ID for the first time, a pop-up will appear asking the taxpayer if the entered Mobile App ID is correct. The taxpayer will click on Yes on this pop-up to change the Mobile App ID.

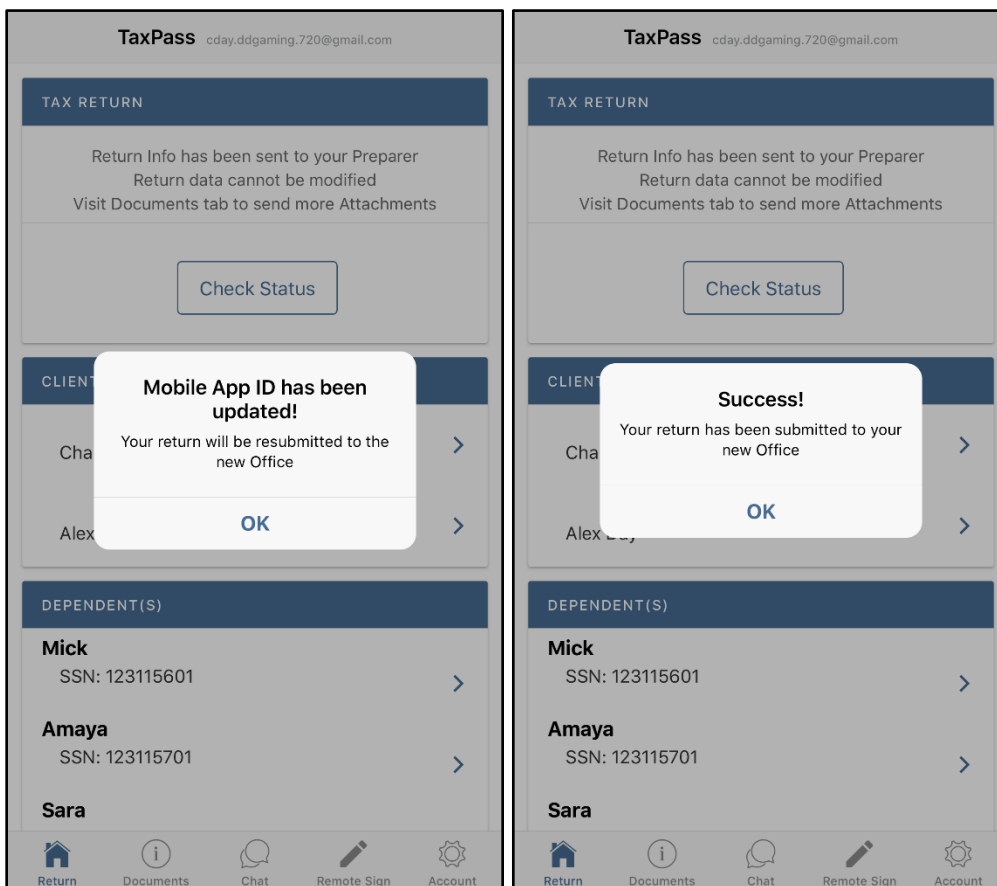

Note: When changing the Mobile App ID after the return has already been submitted, the return will automatically be submitted to the new office (return CANNOT be edited.) Afterwards, the return will no longer be available under TaxPass Mobile App Retrieval in the 2019 software for office one and will only be available for office two (the returns is essentially moved.)

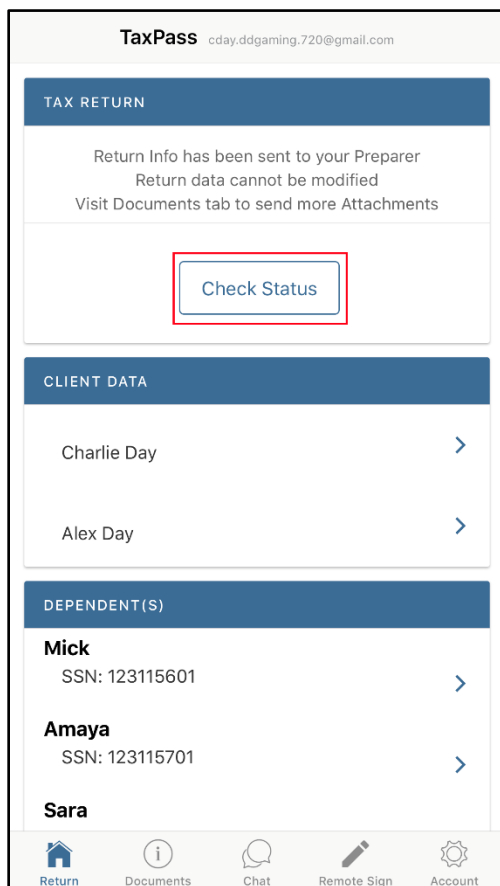

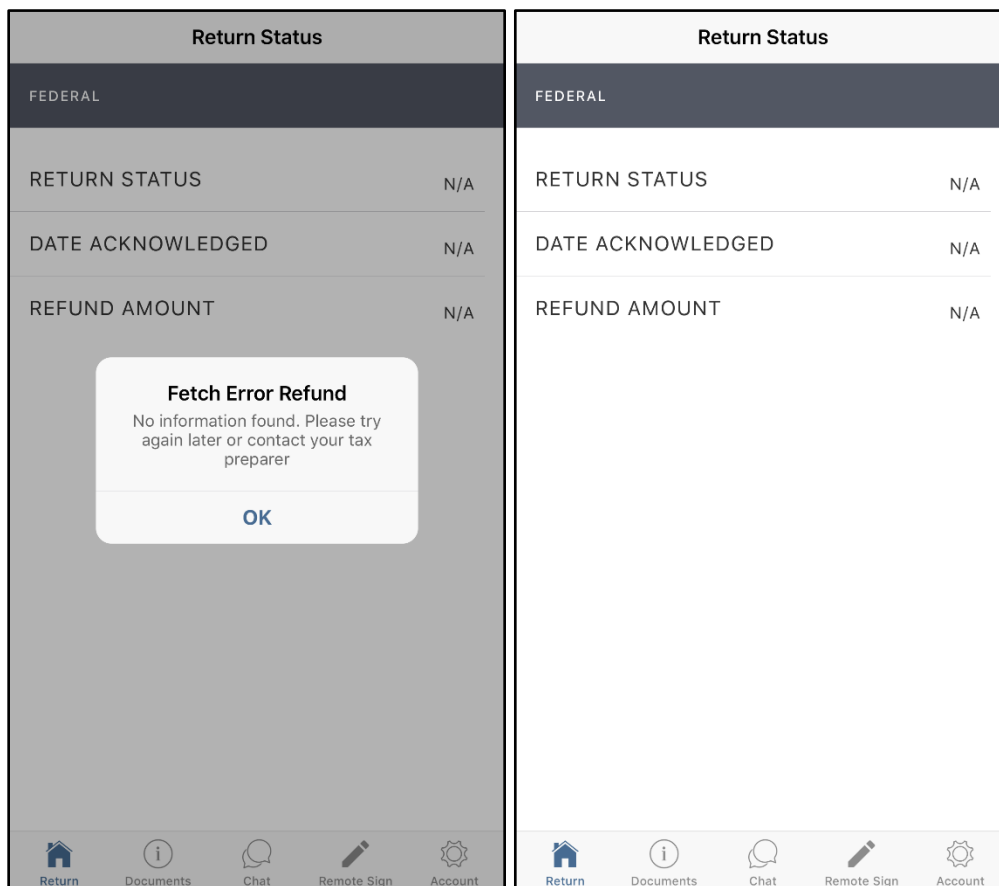
- The Check Status button is used to check the status of the taxpayer's tax return once it has been e-filed by the tax preparer.

TaxPass



- If the taxpayer clicks on the Check Status button after they have submitted their return, but the preparer has not e-filed the return, a service error will appear indicating no e-filed information could be found.

TaxPass



- If the taxpayer clicks on the Check Status button after they have submitted their return and the preparer has e-filed the return, the taxpayer should be able to view the current status of their return.

Note: The example below is of a return submitted from TaxPass version 1 for Tax Year 2017 since the IRS is not accepting Tax Year 2018 returns at the time this document was created. In the previous TaxPass version, this was known as the Where's My Refund Menu.

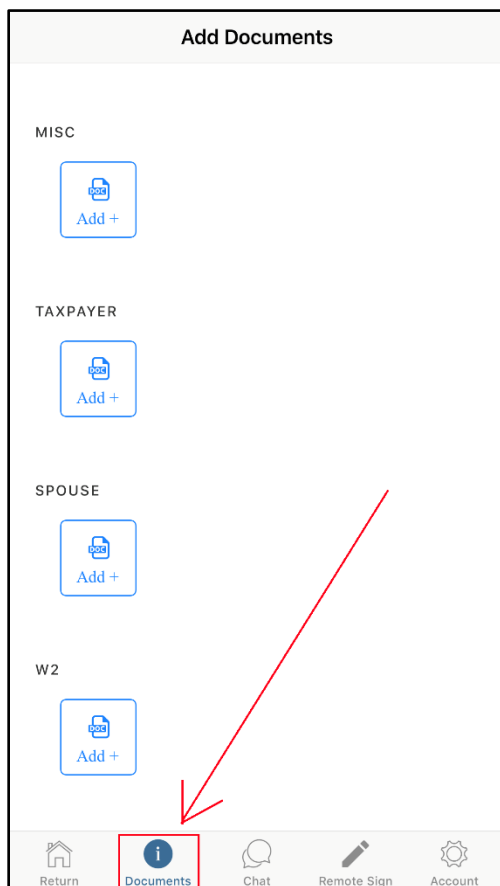

Documents Menu

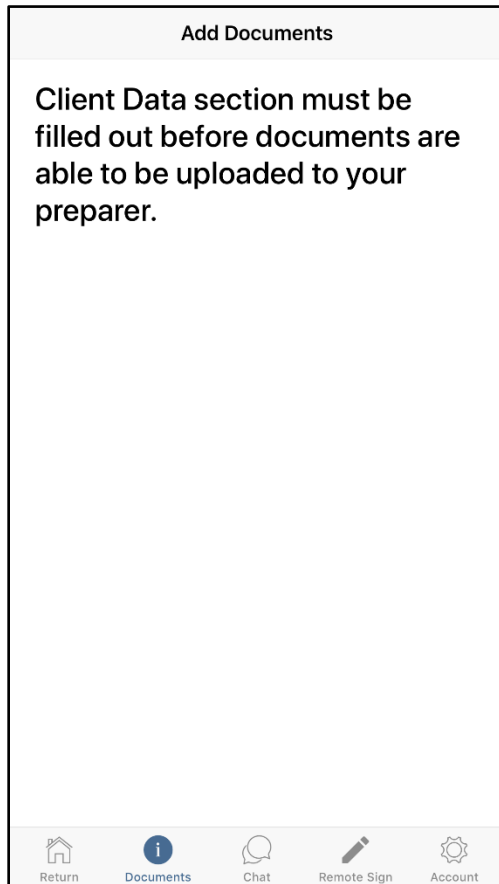
- The Documents menu is used to upload pictures of documents that the taxpayer would like to send to their tax preparer along with their tax return or after the return has been submitted.

- The process of uploading documents through this menu is the same as uploading documents from the Return menu screen – see [Uploading Documents \(Optional\)](#)
- This menu can only be accessed after entering the taxpayer information on the Client Data screens. If the taxpayer clicks on this menu before doing so, they will receive the message below.

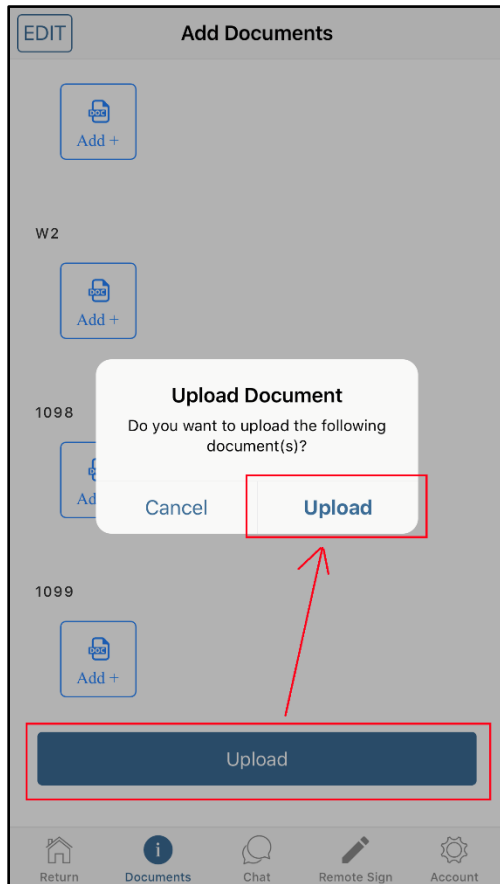
- If the taxpayer has submitted their tax return to the tax preparer but would like to submit additional documents, then the taxpayer must submit these from the Documents menu, as they will be unable to do so from the Return menu.

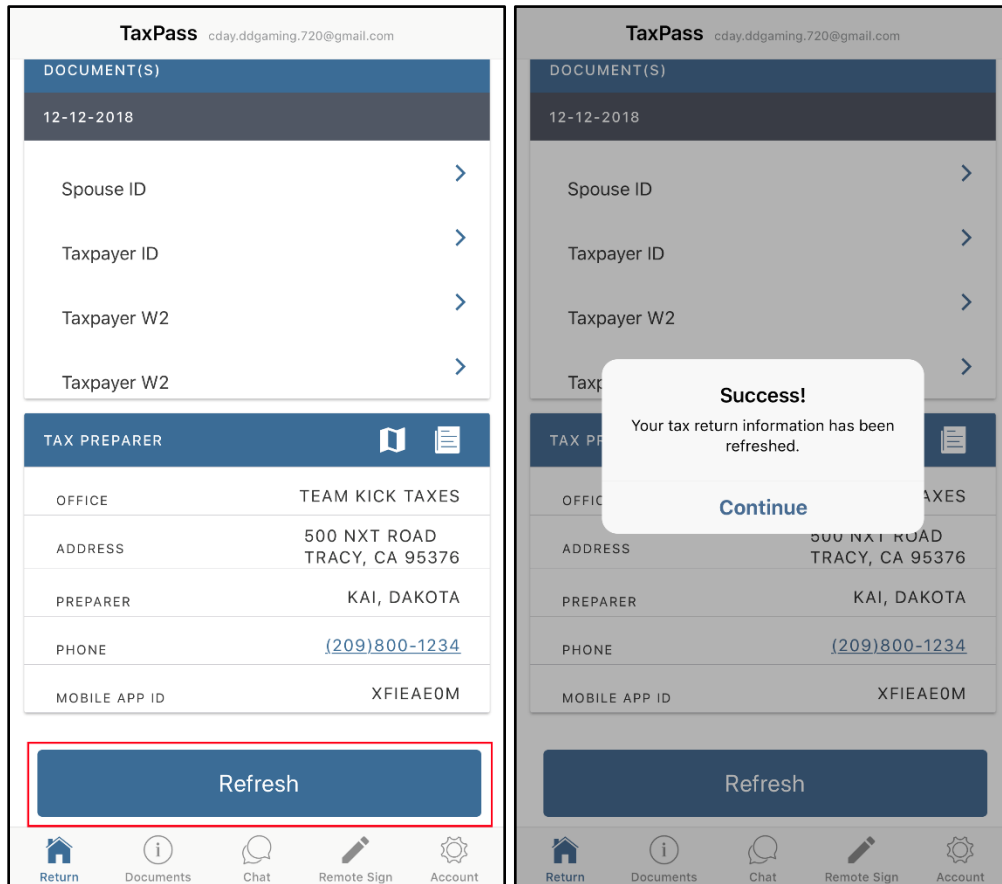
- When submitting documents from the Documents menu, click on the upload button at the bottom of the screen and then the Upload button again on the pop-up. This will upload and submit the documents to the tax preparer **BUT** will not close out the Upload pop-up.

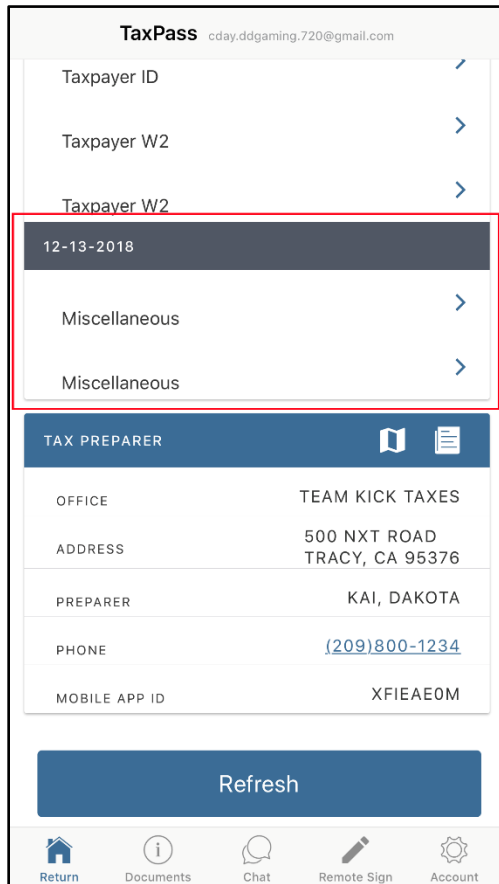

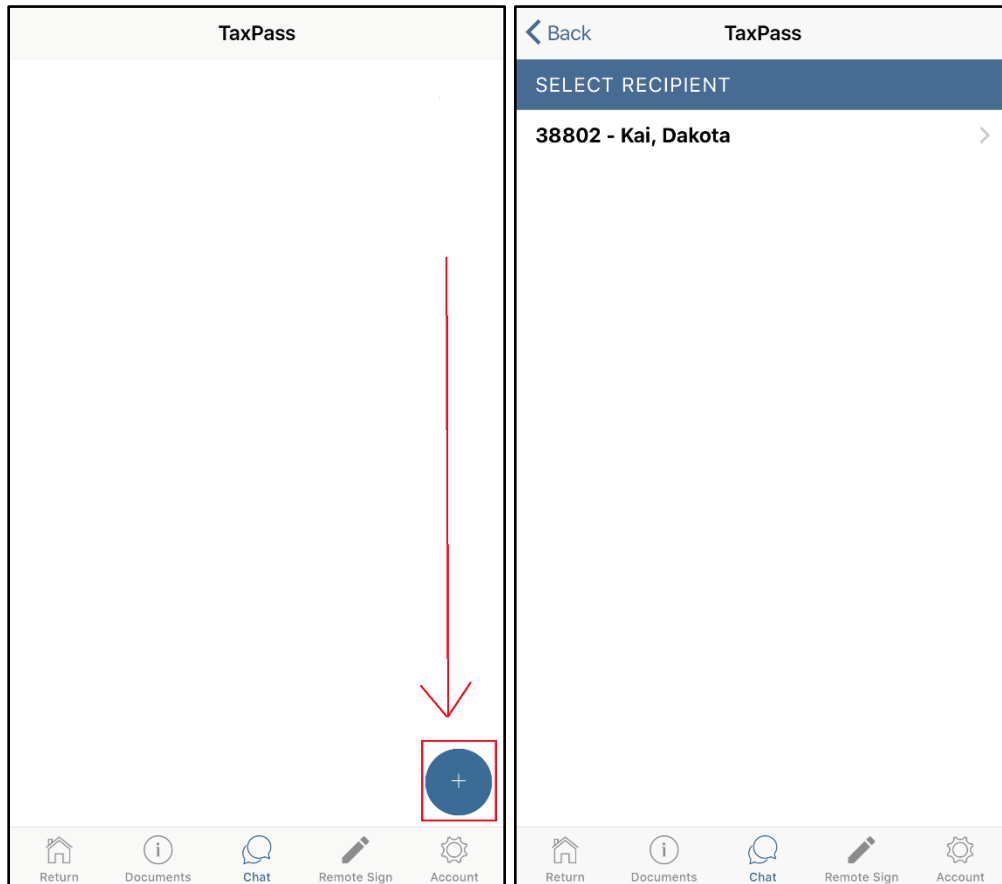

Chat Menu

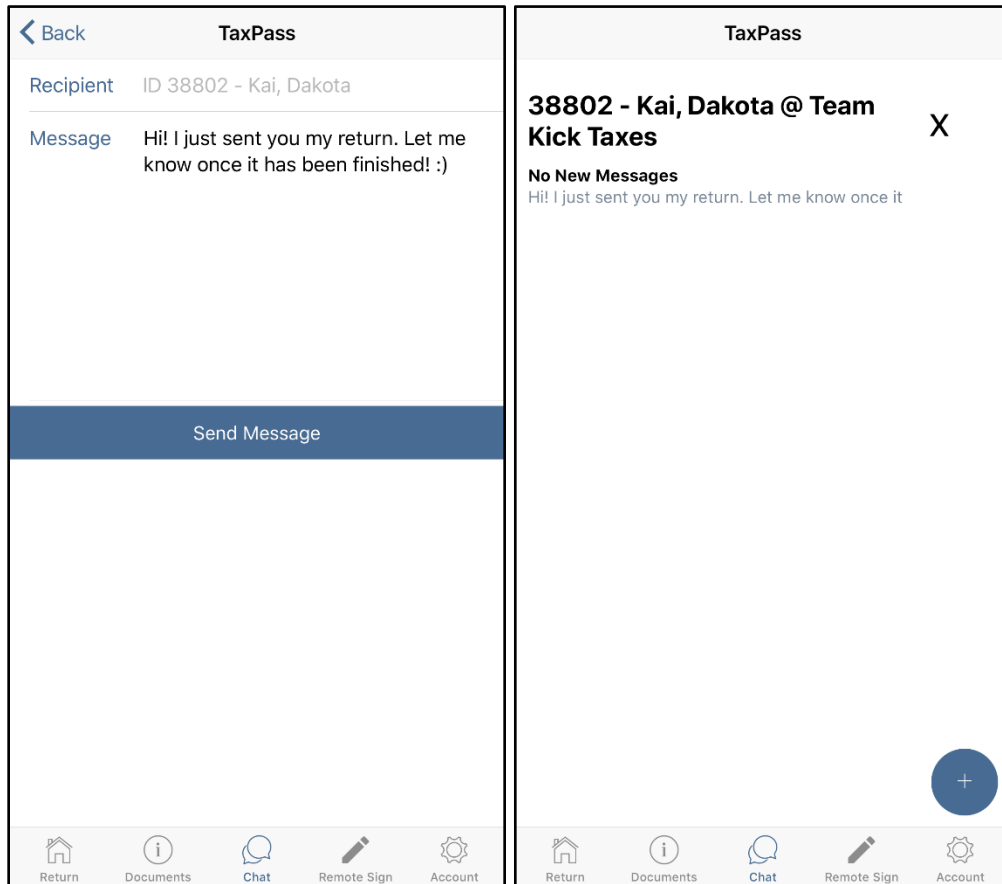
- The Chat menu allows the taxpayer to communicate with their tax preparer via text message, similar to a phone's standard text messaging app.
- When they click on this menu, they will see a message preview window. Click on the blue plus sign on the lower right hand corner to select a recipient (left image below).
- Once they click on the plus sign, the taxpayer will need to select a recipient who they want to send a message to (the tax preparer – right image below.)

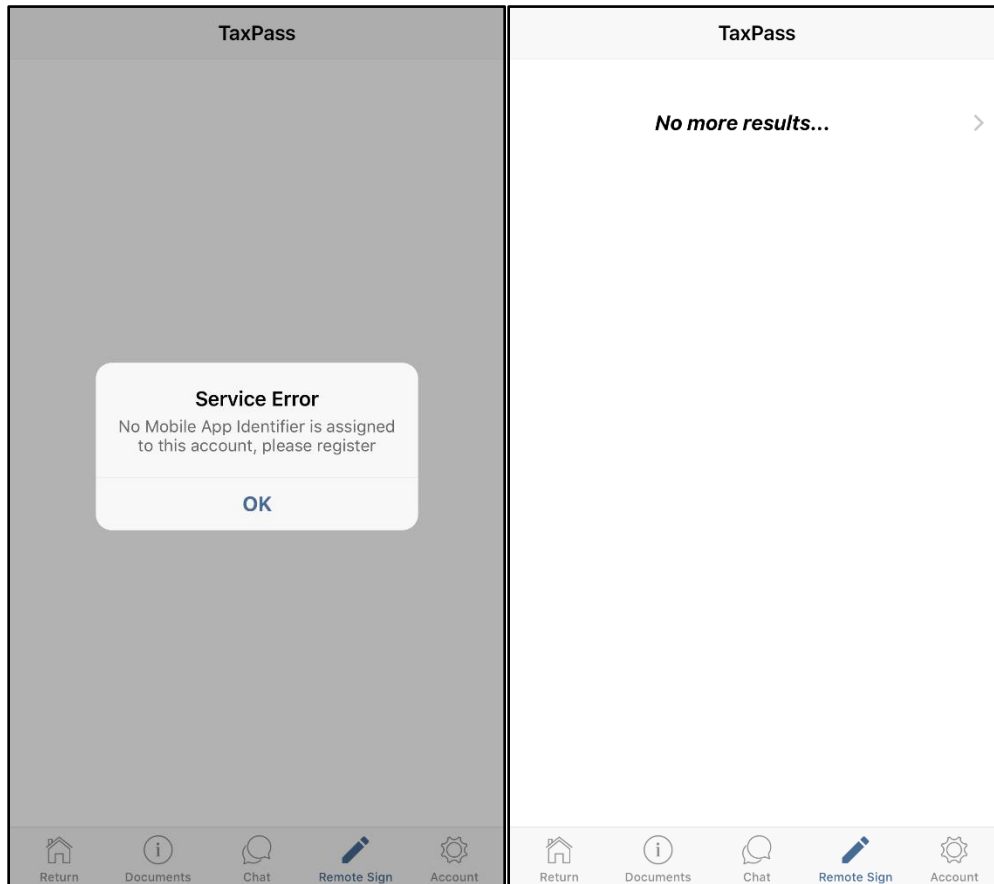

Account Menu

- The Account menu allows the taxpayer to view their account settings. This menu is broken down to four sections:
 1. Personal: displays the taxpayers name and SSN (the first 5 numbers are masked.)
 2. Account: displays the taxpayers' username (email) and tax preparers Mobile App ID.
 3. Admin: allows the taxpayer to change their password.
 4. Logout: contains a Logout button that will log the taxpayer out of TaxPass.
